1.3. Objectives, previous WG meeting minutes' approval, agenda approval

The objectives of the meeting are to update Members of the Precious Metal Cyanides ("PMCN") Work Group ("the WG") on the current status of the different phases of the project, to exchange critical information on the elements necessary to timely progress in the making of the registration dossier, and to agree on the next steps for its finalisation. 2. Registration update

The REACH registration dossier of potassium dicyanoargentate (KAgCN) has been successfully registered by the LR (end of January 2018) and co-registrants are kindly invited to register as soon as possible. All other gold and gold compound dossiers have been successfully registered previously.

4. Opportunities for improvement

For the micronucleus testing proposal of KAgCN the transgenic test is suggested. As this is not in line with other PMC substances a second opinion will be asked to Kirkland and the testing proposal will be adjusted in the dossier of KAgCN. **[A1]**



Previously the comment was made that the DNEL derived for the silver cyanide substances were not in accordance to the TRGS 900 guidance. This is a German national regulation had is not in the scope of the PMC. Therefore this comment will be removed from the opportunities for improvement list.

During the meeting the question was raised if CHESAR could be used for drafting the extended safety data sheets. Currently only the human toxicity data is incorporated in CHESAR and not the ecotoxicity data. Updating CHESAR by including all relevant studies and endpoints is added to the list of opportunities of improvement.
